1. Welcome

Commission chair Dušan Petrovič welcomed all participants, including ICA vice-president and liaison Terje Midtbø and briefly discussed the main activities of the commission, which all can be found at the commission's website <u>www.mountaincartography.org</u>, edited by Klemen Kozmus Trajkovski, from the University of Ljubljana.

2. Minutes of previous meeting in Florence

The approved minutes of the previous meeting in Florence, Italy, are available on the commission's website.

3. Report on activities in 2022 and 2023

At the ICC 2021 in Florence, Italy, were two separate Mountain Cartography related sessions with 13 presentations. They covered various interesting topics. Besides, we held a virtual ICA-CMC meeting on 12^{ve} March 2022 with seven short presentations by commission members focusing on interesting projects that they have worked on since we last met.

4. Workshop 2023 Colorado

Young scientist award was given to one young scientist who presented his work at the workshop: Andrew Tyrrell (NZL).

The workshop program is accessible on the commission homepage at <u>www.mountaincartography.org</u>. Online posting of the presentations will follow in May; participants were asked to submit their corrected presentations or request not to be published. The images will be available there, as well.

The proceedings of the 12^{ve} Mountain Cartography Workshop in Colorado will be available at the beginning of the next year at the latest in digital form only, prepared by the Copernicus publishing. The submission deadline for the proceedings is the June 15 2023.

5. ICC 2023 Cape Town

Call for contributions was closed and the abstracts were revised, authors were announced about acceptance. We don't know yet, how many separate Mountain Cartography related sessions will be there.

There will be General assembly at ICC 2023. For this event, the Commission needs to prepare a regular report, template will follow. Propose revised Terms of reference, and nomination of Pat Kennelly as a Chair for the next four-year period has been submitted. Commission members support the proposal. Possible Co-chair can be nominated after election of the chair at the ICC.

6. Report form ICA liaison

ICA liaison Terje Midtbø welcomed the participants and invited all commission members to contribute Cartographic concepts in Body of Knowledge (CartoBoK). The flyer will be sent to commission's members.

7. Workshop 2024 Zakopane, Poland

Dušan Petrovič presented a proposed venue for the next workshop in 2024 in Zakopane, Poland, prepared by Rafal Jonca, who would be the local organizer with help from commission members – newly elected and past Chair. After the discussion the date for the workshop was agreed to take place on April 3 – 7 2024.

8. ICC 2025 Vancouver, Canada

The next ICA conference will take place Vancouver, Canada, 28 July – 1 August 2025. All CMC members are encouraged to participate and submit abstracts on the topic of mountain cartography.

9. Possible future workshops

Some ideas about possible locations for the 2026 workshop are France (Manon Boshard, Yann Boulanger, Nolan Mestres, Joëlle Thollot), Norway (Bjørn Sandvik) and Russia (Timofey Samsonov). The final decision about the location and the date will be discussed and decided at meetings during Workshop 2024 Zakopane, Poland and ICC 2025 Vancouver, Canada.
